

Subject: 2017 Activity Report

I am pleased to present to the Board a report of Wall Fire District No. 3 activity for the year of 2017. The department responded to 416 incidents in 2017, an increase of 20 incidents compared to the prior year.

Our department currently operates with manpower of 1 full time firefighter and 44 volunteers. Of those volunteer 22 firefighters responded to over 15 percent of our call volume.

The average response time for incidents requiring emergency response was 5 minutes and 24 seconds.

I would like to emphasize our career firefighter responded to 33 EMS or PD assists as well as responded to 155 calls for service total.

Members attended a total of 35 training drills in 2017 for a total of 655 attendees and 1,864.39 man hours.


This year, I have included specific information regarding our manpower and response activity. This includes the plan to move all apparatus to the Main House for response. Furthermore, I also included the progress of our Rescue services.

#### Highlights of 2017 include:


- Engine 378 was relocated to the Main House in June due to manpower issues.
- New SCOTT self-contained breathing apparatus was purchased and placed into service.
- New Paratech Rescue equipment was purchased and placed into service.
- The membership was outfitted in new Class B Uniforms.
- Standard Operating Procedures were reviewed and will continue to be improved for maximum safety of members and impact of service.
- Following the transition of all members responding to the main house, there was a large improvement on apparatus responding with 4 or more members.

To minimize previous manpower problems during daytime hours, the District decided to hire two full time firefighters, bringing our total of career staff to 3 firefighters.







Members responded out of district for mutual and automatic aid for a total of 59 times in 2017. This was dramatically increased due to the successful implementation of the Box Alarm.


The automatic aid was also increased as a result of a policy change, as District 3 now responds to all reported extrications in town.
